What is JETRO, anyway? Something to do with airplanes? A warehouse store? Actually, there is one by that name, but not at all related to this JETRO : the **Japan External Trade Organization**. Established in 1958 as a government-related organization to promote Japanese exports abroad, JETRO currently focuses on bringing foreign investment to Japan, and helping small/medium-size Japanese companies maximize their exports. Think of it as a Chamber of Commerce for the whole country of Japan.

JETRO has four main aims:

1. Help U.S. companies establish a Japan office

--Free market information and support to U.S. businesses looking to do business in the Japanese market. Advice on high-tech markets with optimal opportunities for success.

2. Help U.S. companies find Japanese business partners

--Business matching programs to help US companies find potential Japanese business partners

3. Connect U.S. investors with cutting edge Japanese technology

--JETRO connects U.S. investors, entrepreneurs and dealmakers with cutting edge Japanese technology ventures seeking to accelerate their growth in the U.S.

4. Showcase premium Japanese goods
